We opened up the **2007 Seven Artisans Petite Sirah** the other night... The Seven Artisans hails from the Suisun Valley, clocks in at 14.9% alcohol by volume, has a real cork closure, and retails for \$17.99.

On the nose I got blueberries, cream, blackberries, blue fruit, pie, vanilla, blueberry cobbler, fruit punch, more blue fruit and blueberries...more blueberries, blueberries, and blueberries. After this got going, it was extremely aromatic and yummy smelling. In the mouth I found fresh tart blueberries, blackberry, raspberries, more red fruit on the edges, bittersweet chocolate, anise, some more raspberries and blue fruit on the finish. This had tannins to spare...so decant. Or stick it in the basement for a couple years. Yum!
